

PROCEDURE:

- Gather equipment and all necessary single-use products required for the exam.
 - Bring only the necessary items in the room. Leave extra materials and products outside of the room.
 - No multi-use materials are brought into room.
- **Don N95 & PPE**
 - Perform hand hygiene
 - Don isolation gown
 - Don N95
 - Perform a seal check
 - Perform negative/positive seal check by doing the following:
 - When taking a sharp breath in, the mask should pucker in slightly. If it does not readjust the fit and mold the mask gently to fit the face.
 - When breathing out no air should be felt around the perimeter. Pay attention to air movement over your face. If you feel air coming out it is not a tight seal.
 - Readjust the respirator and perform the seal check again.
 - If a tight seal cannot be achieved the respirator should not be used. Ask a PPE Extender or IPC Liaison for assistance before proceeding.
 - Ensure the mask is breathable, if unable to breathe in the mask, the respirator cannot be re-used.
 - Don eye protection (face shield or goggles)
 - Don gloves
 - Perform safety check
 - Enter the patient room with mobile equipment and all materials required for the procedure or exam

FOLLOWING THE PROCEDURE OR EXAM, PRIOR TO EXITING:

- Discard procedure or exam waste in the trash
- Clean visible debris on mobile equipment, if present
- Move equipment close to the exit
- **Doffing**
 - Inside patient room
 - Perform hand hygiene
 - Doff gown
 - Doff gloves
 - Perform hand hygiene
 - Move clean equipment out of the room and into the corridor
 - Exit patient room, close door tightly
 - Outside of patient room
 - Perform hand hygiene
 - Don clean gloves
 - Perform cleaning/disinfection of all surfaces, including wheels and hard to reach surfaces, using a low level disinfectant
 - Clean/disinfect surface for doffing eye protection
 - Doff face shield or goggles
 - Clean/disinfect eye protection and lay on clean surface
 - Perform hand hygiene
 - Doff N95, place in pre-labeled brown paper bag
 - Doff gloves
 - Perform hand hygiene
