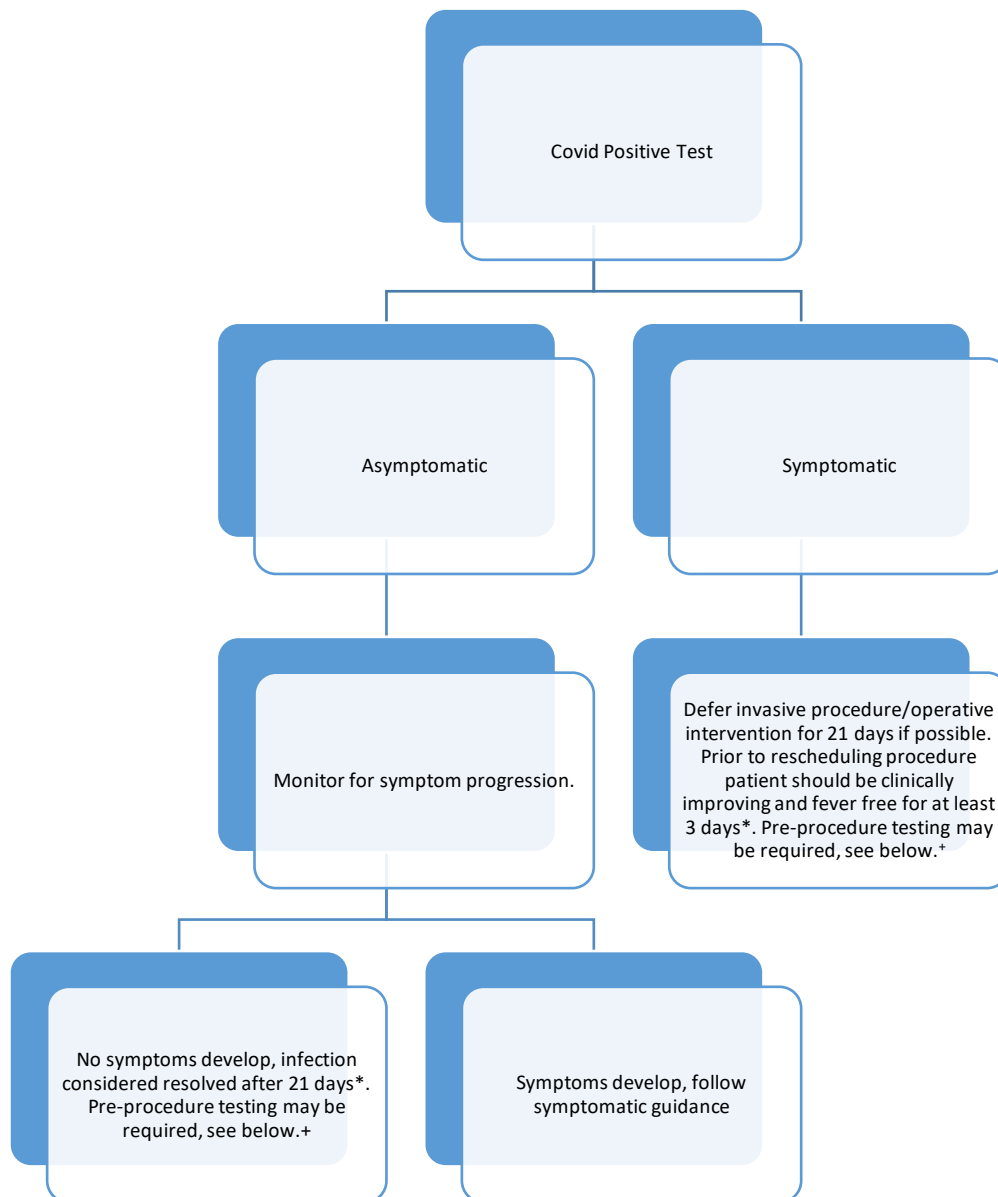

Pre-procedural Testing Algorithm for COVID-19 Positive Patients (Updated 01/04/2022)

*Patients may have exited home isolation based on isolation duration guidance but must still follow pre-procedure guidance for the full 21 days. Any procedure done within 21 days of a COVID diagnosis requires COVID PPE or confirmation of one negative PCR test or being cleared from isolation by COVID ID.

+Due to breakthrough infections with the Omicron variant, any patient with a COVID infection prior to January 7, 2022 requires repeat COVID testing even if within 90 days from their last COVID infection. Any new COVID19 infections with a first positive test on or after January 7, 2022 do not require repeat COVID19 testing for 90 days (as per past protocols).
